INTRODUCTION: NATAL CHART

Astrology/astronomy is the oldest recorded science known to man. Much precious space has been given to recording the appearance, disappearance, and cyclical movements of the Sun, Moon, planets and stars in early man's tedious efforts to communicate his history AND his ideas to future generations. Sumerian cuneiform script on clay tablets dating back over 2,000 years BC had texts correlating time (calendars) to the heavenly bodies. Many tablets also displayed some of the same glyphs and characters that we use today in astrology, while others recorded the close correlation observed between earthly and celestial phenomena.

In the seventh century BC, Assyrian Astrologers became quite sophisticated in predicting eclipses and retrogradation of the planets by observing their movements against the background of the stars and constellations. These observations provided the earliest body of knowledge on which the study of both Astrology and Astronomy are based today. However, this was not the purpose of their observations. The astrologer's responsibilities were to provide their priests and rulers with favorable and unfavorable times for religious and social activities, and for the affairs of state. As a result of their efforts, a considerable body of knowledge and astrological lore was accumulated and recorded.

Early man gazed at the planets and stars and discovered that their positions in the heavens and their distances from each other were constantly changing, and that those changes formed patterns which were repeated and predictable. He observed that all of nature in his world was directly related to those changes. Confined as he was to a small patch of earth where even boundaries and limits were unknown, it is little wonder that he began to correlate the events in his own life with the cycles of the planets and the stars, and to seek to live in harmony with their changing patterns and with nature.

Today's man, through the science of Astronomy, uses these same stars to guide him on his personal visits to some of these heavenly bodies. Astronomy also helps modern man to place his own stars (satellites) in the sky. Some of these provide forms of communication which would be as difficult for early man to believe and understand as it seems to be for some Astronomers and others to believe that the ORIGINAL planets can still communicate influences to man today. Since these influences affect only the feelings, and the individual does have free will to make his own decisions, Astrology cannot meet a "scientific test" of "repeated results under controlled conditions". Neither can religion, for that matter, yet most people believe in some form of religion.

Astrologers have been observing correlations of "As Above, So Below" for centuries, resulting in a tremendous body of knowledge. They are constantly studying, comparing, defining, delineating, and recording these influences and their meanings. Today, sophisticated computers make these tasks easier and the information more reliable. Thanks to the diligence of the ancients for preserving the records and to the enormous capacity of computers to store and sort information, today's Astrologer can cast a better chart and interpret it more accurately and completely than ever before.

The Natal Chart interpretations are found by computing the astrological data for the date, time, and place of your birth. Your chart is unique in its combination of planetary positions, aspects, and influences. There are literally thousands of variables in the natal chart alone, and each individual

will usually have less than a hundred of these variables in his or her chart. We will print all of those which apply to your particular birth time and place, and they are what make you the unique individual that you are. We try to present this information in such a way that you can recognize and interpret the "blueprint" of your own "Personality Profile."

There will be Delineations that appear to absolutely contradict each other, and there will be some that you cannot believe applies to you at all. Please try to keep an open mind and read the Natal Report all the way through. We will address all these concerns, and more, on the last page.

Astrology is not "fatalism". "What Is To Be" is not necessarily what WILL be. The individual always has free will to make his/her own choices. Your horoscope reveals the astrological imprints upon your personality at the time of your birth. It has been up to you to decide which influences to accept and which influences to challenge. Personal growth results from those choices. Read the interpretation of your Natal chart and look back on your life. Is this you? Was this you? We think you will be amazed!

Given below is some technical data that your astrological analysis is based on. This data is derived from the date, time, and place of your birth, and is unique in that it applies ONLY to YOU.

YOUR ASTROLOGICAL IDENTITY

The sign which the Sun was in when you were born tends to give you your astrological identity. How many times have you heard the question, "What sign are you"? . . . How many times have you had people identify themselves with the statement: "I am a Leo, I am an Aries, I am a Pisces", etc. . . . Many times for both questions, I am sure.

Practically everyone knows his or her own Sun-sign. You probably have also noticed that most people have heard some simplistic Sun-sign interpretations and they are likely to add, "I am a natural leader--I'm a Leo, you know"; or, "Of course I have a temper, I'm an Aries"; or, "Pisces people are naturally psychic".

These generalities are sometimes accurate, but not all Leos are leaders, not all Arians have temper tantrums, nor, are all Pisceans especially psychic. Even when these simplistic statements are true, there are many more influences in the Sun-sign of each individual and many other astrological influences that affect that individual's personality. If astrology were taken no farther than the Sun-sign, it would be telling us that we are like every other person who was born under our particular Sun-sign!

The Sun sign IS perhaps the most important SINGLE factor among the thousands of variables drawn from when setting up the horoscope. Through the sign it occupies at the time of your birth, it colors your personality so strongly that it usually can be recognized throughout your lifetime. It indicates the ways in which you express your basic energy potential and your creative drive to grow and develop as an individual. It is also one of the major factors from which you draw upon to develop your personal identity and self worth.

You have only one Sun-sign, however, and even if it IS the most powerful of all the stellar bodies, its influences are modified by the house in which it is found and by its hemispheric location in the chart. Its relationship to the Natal Moon is also legendary, and warrants special attention in the interpretation process. Even more modifications can be expected from the aspects of the Sun to the other planets and to the Ascendant and Midheaven, from what "Mode" and "Element" it is in, and by the house positions of the sign Leo, which is "ruled" by the Sun. When you take all these things into consideration you can certainly see that there is much, much more to your identity than your Sun-sign.

However, this popular interest in Sun-sign astrology does account for a proliferation of Sun-sign publications, and one can find Sun-sign interpretations and legends in literally hundreds of astrological books and magazines today.

In the following delineation of the Sun-sign in your chart, we have tried to include those influences that are most consistent in the interpretations of the ancients, the masters of astrology, and the teachers of astrology--as well as those of the many gifted researchers and newcomers in astrology today.

SUN IN SCORPIO

The Sun is in Scorpio from approximately October 23 through November 21. Key words are regeneration, resourcefulness, and secrecy: key phrase is "I desire". In many ways, Scorpio is the most powerful sign in the Zodiac because it is ruled by Mars and Pluto. People born under this sign deal with the processes of fundamental transformation on all levels.

Llewellyn George in his "A to Z Horoscope Maker and Delineator" (Llewellyn Publishing, Thirty-sixth Printing, 1974), writes: "In Scorpio the Sun gives strong characteristics and shrewd, keen judgment. The Scorpion native is critical, suspicious, skeptical but enterprising, reserved, tenacious, determined and secretive. Fond of luxuries but economical and calculating; restless, energetic, fond of travel especially on water and admires grandeur in nature. Attends to own affairs in business but in matters of duty may make trouble for others. In speech plain, blunt, sarcastic and forceful; in politics or law very aggressive. At best, original, scientific, sagacious, daring and creative, capable of much success through bold enterprise. Fine engineers, contractors, surgeons, chemists, detectives and sheriffs are born in this sign." (Circa 1908.)

Max Heindel (Rosicrucians, 1927), writes: "The Sun in Scorpio, when well aspected, gives great energy, courage and independence. It makes the mind active, and favors success in such occupations as those of the surgeon or soldier. It also tends to improve the finances after marriage, but tends to extravagance. The Sun here afflicted gives the person a very blunt, brusque manner, a feeling that his judgment is better than that of others, and a tendency to ride rough-shod over anybody or anything that stands in his way. It often makes him indifferent to suffering, and may transform the surgeon into a vivisectionist."

Your Sun in Scorpio gives you power, will, and intense emotional desires. Your life is likely to be a constant struggle to conquer desire through creative use of the will. In general, you try to improve the status quo. In all your endeavors, it is important that you embark upon the proper course from the start, since you will act with all your power. Your perfectionism makes it difficult for you to delegate responsibility, consequently you tend to overwork in order to achieve perfection in all details. Whatever you do, you do it with concentration and enthusiasm. You are extremely strong-willed and tenacious in pursuing your objectives. Fierce pride, courage, and emotional strength are yours in abundance.

You are not often the diplomat, but can be rather blunt in expressing your feelings and ideas. You have an intense curiosity to know the nature of things and how things work. You could excel in scientific research, or in any work involving investigation and detection. You also tend to be very secretive, and will not tolerate anyone betraying your trust or a confidence.

You love mysteries and are deeply attracted to the dark and secret side of life. You never take things at face value and are always probing beneath the surface of people and situations to discover what is REALLY going on. You tend to be more of a cynic than an idealist. Your intuition is well developed as a rule, often allowing you to penetrate the thoughts of others. You need to develop that intuition at a spiritual level and tap the power of the creative and regenerative forces of nature. With that connection, your accomplishments could begin to border on the miraculous.

You have a high sense of justice. Although you may despise weakness in yourself and don't like to see it in others, you can be compassionate to the point of over-extending yourself to help someone else. You have tremendous staying power and will see things through to the bitter end. However, your patience will come to an abrupt halt if you perceive that those you are trying to help are making no effort to help themselves.

You also have a powerful need for deep emotional involvement and you form very intense attachments and love bonds. You are possessive and often jealous of anyone or anything that you perceive as a threat to your relationships with those you love. When you commit yourself to someone, you are whole-heartedly devoted and expect complete loyalty in return. You merge with or "marry" the person you love at a very deep level and therefore separations are extremely painful for you--often stormy and nasty. When you have been wounded, you are not inclined to turn the other cheek and will retaliate if at all possible. Certainly you will never forget the injury, and you may hang onto resentments for a long time. Forgiveness doesn't come easily to you.

You cannot live at a superficial level, and whatever you become involved with is generally of serious consequence. At sometime in your life, there is almost certain to be a combination of circumstances or a crises of such impact that you will feel your whole life has been completely changed. You may be totally aware when you reach this turning point, or (if you are lucky) it could seem so insignificant that only when you look back on it, you will realize that your total outlook on life is different. Even positive change can be painful, but you can be sure that the new direction your life will take after this metamorphosis is a path toward higher purpose and more rewarding achievements.

YOUR RISING SIGN

It would be impossible to even estimate the number of individuals who share your Sun sign, but just the opposite is true for your Rising sign. Only those who were born at the same geographic location and at the same exact moment of time could share the same precise second, minute, and degree of the sign upon your Ascendant. A difference in birth time of even a few minutes and/or a few degrees of latitude or longitude can alter the signs upon the houses and the locations of planets within the houses.

The horoscope is a circle, and the whole is made up of its many parts. The well-known Swiss psychoanalyst, Dr. Carl Jung, coined the term, "Synchronicity", for life within the horoscope. Under that concept, the Rising sign represents the beginning of the natal chart as birth represents the beginning of life--the first part of synchronization. Like the horoscope, life is also a circle whose whole is made up of its many parts. Unlike the familiar TV beer commercial, however, we DO "Go around" more than once, and it CAN "Get better than this".

Astrology, by way of the horoscope, symbolically divides life into twelve general areas called houses. There is a sign of the Zodiac upon the cusp (beginning) of each house. Your rising sign (Ascendant) is on the cusp of your first house, and signs upon the rest of the houses are determined progressively from that sign which was rising on the eastern horizon at the exact time and place of your birth. This makes your horoscope as individual and unique to your personal identity as are your fingerprints.

Some astrologers refer to the interpretation of the rising sign as the Mask we show the world--our public image. It is that part of our personality that we feel safe in allowing others to see. It may also disguise those facets of ourselves that we would prefer to keep to ourselves. Consequently, the delineation of influences from your rising sign could very well be descriptions of the way other people see you, though not necessarily the way you see yourself. It is certainly not the whole you or the ONLY you, but it could provide you with a valuable source of insight for enhancing your own self-awareness.

As you read the delineations of your chart, remember we are painting a composite portrait of your personality as revealed by the most prominent astrological influences in force at the moment of your birth. However, for each year of your life, the Sun has touched each point in your chart again. The Moon does this every twenty-eight days: Saturn, every twenty-eight to thirty-one years--and so with all the planets and parts within their own time circle. The ways in which you have dealt with the stresses and supports of your birth imprints and the subsequent aspects applied to your circle of life up to now will help to explain the person you are today.

Some delineations of specific aspects may appear to contradict others in your chart. Actually, there are no contradictions in Astrology--at least no more than there are in the human psyche. We are seeking a blend. It is in the interpretation of the whole chart and its application to the circle of your life that we begin to appreciate Dr. Jung's word, "Synchronicity".

Directly following your Rising sign we will interpret the influences of the signs on the houses (two

through twelve) in your Natal chart. These signs are a natural progression from the Ascendant according to the house system used. We use the "Placidus" house system in our work. With this system some houses could enclose a complete sign, and there could be the same sign on two houses, but since it allows for the curvature of the earth, we believe it places the coordinates most accurately to the east and west in both hemispheres.

SAGITTARIUS RISING

People with Sagittarius rising may appear very practical and idealistic at the same time. The ruler of Sagittarius rising is Jupiter, the "Great Benefic". According to the ancients, Jupiter is the planet of "Luck", and even modern Astrologers relate its influences to optimism, good humor, and a happy-go-lucky manner. It also bestows a philosophical attitude and strong religious nature. Sagittarius is a Fire sign, indicating great enthusiasm. It is in the Mutable mode, signifying adaptability.

Other people see you as a good sport and a good friend, but possibly one who is not always consistent and dependable. You may also be seen as a wise person, since you do not get bogged down in pettiness and trivialities. You appear to be able to communicate a larger way of looking at situations and for ways of opening up new pathways. Others see you as a person who believes in miracles and grace, or just plain good luck: as someone who never gives up on life, and who will inspire and encourage others to keep looking forward.

Others may feel that you have your feet planted firmly on the ground, but with your eyes in the skies. You need constant challenges and goals to stimulate you. You are only comfortable with a positive, enthusiastic, and happy outlook, even when the facts are contrary. You need to feel that everything will turn out okay in order to deal with life as it is. You may go your way with a happy-go-lucky manner, showing great enthusiasm and adaptability. You have a philosophical attitude and strong religious nature. Most of all, you want to experience life. You never want to be limited--you cannot stand shackles of any kind. You may hesitate to settle into any kind of lifestyle for this reason.

You are a nature lover, and your religious nature may find great expression through meditation on universal nature. You are likely to get the same kind of feeling from a beautiful sunset as some others get from more traditional religious experiences. You can wax philosophical, and are firmly convinced that better things are just around the corner.

Others will expect much from you, for your natural optimism is likely to make you an overachiever, constantly setting unrealistic goals for yourself (and others), which, with luck, you just might be able to pull off. Your enthusiasm will inspire others, but you need to be aware that you tend to expect them to adopt your attitude lest you be disappointed in them. You also need to watch your tendency to exaggerate in order to make reality seem more desirable and goals more easily achieved.

You could be successful in more than one career. When you have truly mastered something you need to go on to new activity. Your natural optimism coupled with your curiosity and ability to influence and inspire others are all leadership traits. Your best vocational choices are probably in human services areas, such as teaching or social services. You have difficulty understanding man's

inhumanity to man, and you are likely to get involved with causes relating to intolerance and discrimination.

Though some persons may see you as a "good catch", you need to be especially careful in relationships. You are likely to be attracted to those which promise a challenge, to someone who is out of reach, or about to get away. If you should conquer such a possible flighty, insincere person, you could then become disenchanted. You are only interested in someone who intrigues you, but you need a stimulating, truly intellectual partner for any kind of long term companion. Your need for freedom will make you miserable if you feel trapped in a relationship. You cannot tolerate being caged for very long, and friends and loved ones must respect your need for freedom of movement. Binding commitments and responsibilities often weigh heavily upon you and you may resist "growing up" and taking on the limitations of adult life.

You probably will appear young and fresh all your life. It is difficult to get you down, but when this happens you are likely to hide it very well with your natural optimism. You seldom lose anyone from your life unless you walk away, for you are usually forgiven even unforgivable behavior. You seem to do everything with wild abandon, and can outlast almost everyone around.

AQUARIUS ON 2ND HOUSE--Uranus is the ruler of Aquarius and when it is found on the second house of money, worth and finances, you are likely to earn money through original and unusual ways. You will be drawn to large corporations or institutions or may work through large groups and organizations. Innovative and ingenious techniques will be your contributions.

PISCES ON 3RD HOUSE--The mystical sign of Pisces is ruled by Neptune, planet of confusion and delusion--or of imagination and inspiration. This house position can cause you to be very emotional in your thoughts and communications. You like to be alone when doing mental work, and can be rather cryptic in communicating. Most of your ideas are based on intuitive insight.

ARIES ON 4TH HOUSE--Aries is ruled by Mars, the planet of action. When found on the fourth house of home and domestic affairs, it can make you rather aggressive in matters relating to home and family. You are likely to have many mechanical devices and implements in the home. Home can also be a battlefield for emotional spats.

TAURUS ON 5TH HOUSE--Taurus is ruled by Venus, planet of love, art, and aesthetics. On the fifth house of love and romance, children, sex, and (other) entertainment, you are consistent in love and affection toward your children. You take pride in their accomplishments and want them to have the very best of everything. You also gain pleasure from luxurious surroundings and good food. You can be extremely romantic. You appreciate art, sculpture, and music.

GEMINI ON 6TH HOUSE--Gemini is ruled by Mercury and Mercury is also ruler of the sixth house. On the cusp of this sixth house of work, service, and health they can provide the intellectual approach to the matters of the house. You are versatile and ingenious in organizing your work, and can handle several jobs at once. You have many good ideas on how to increase efficiency, and a fraternal attitude toward co-workers and employees gives you great management ability.

GEMINI ON 7TH HOUSE--Mercury rules Gemini. With this sign on the seventh house of marriage, partnership, and the public, the first indication is that there will be more than one marriage. You attract people who are multi-talented and who express themselves well. If things are not going well in a relationship, you can detach intellectually much easier than you can emotionally. You sometimes prefer to let others do the talking for you in public situations.

LEO ON 8TH HOUSE--The Sun is ruler of Leo, and on the eighth house of legal affairs, insurance, death, inheritance, and other people's money, it promises leadership and ingenuity. You are likely to be generous, assertive, and flamboyant, but you are likely to want to control all of the joint resources. You will avoid references to death, and could postpone all responsibilities relating to final preparations.

VIRGO ON 9TH HOUSE--Mercury, the planet of communications and intellect rules Virgo. When it is found on this house of philosophy, religion, higher education, publication, and travel it indicates an organized, detailed, and well thought out approach to any of these affairs. You may spend so much time planning and thinking about the affairs of this house that you never get around to actually doing them. Try to allow yourself to be a little more spontaneous.

LIBRA ON 10TH HOUSE--Venus, planet of love, talents and material possessions rules Libra. This configuration on the tenth house of ambition, career and honor can provide a great boost toward professional success. You have a strong sense of ethics in your profession or vocation. You can win over people in power and further your own professional goals. You may have professional partners to help you achieve your ambitions.

SCORPIO ON 11TH HOUSE--Scorpio is ruled by Pluto, planet of regeneration. When on the eleventh house of friends, goals, and love received, you are likely to surround yourself with dynamic, aggressive, and powerful friends. You may be reserved to the point where you can appear cold and superior, but there is always passion underneath. You may tend to dominate group activities, and you need to learn to let your soft side show.

SAGITTARIUS ON 12TH HOUSE--Jupiter rules Sagittarius and when we find it on the twelfth house of limitations, the subconscious mind, and hidden meanings there can be much "hidden" support to guide you in making decisions. Ideas and the means for carrying them out can seem to come out of nowhere, and the intuition is usually uncanny.

THE PLANETS: POSITIONS AND ASPECTS

Astrology recognizes ten major "heavenly bodies" in the Universe that radiate various influences toward earth, and thus manifest themselves in the lives and affairs of mankind. The Sun and the Moon influences are most recognizable because some of them are visible and tactile, such as light and heat. They also provide the base for mankind's calculation of time--the calendar and the clock. Influences distributed by the other eight planets may be less visible and more subtle, but not less real.

These emanations are constant, but the intensity of their influences can be tempered by the sign they are in, the house of your chart in which they are located, and by their angular aspects to each other. We touched upon this in the introduction to the Ascendant when we also introduced the term "synchronicity". In the following pages we will print the individual interpretations of each planet in your chart with respect to the sign it is in, and its house position.

Following that we will print the interpretation of the planetary aspects to each other. Aspects are specific angles between two or more planets that have been found to modify the influences bestowed. Technically, every angle between planets creates an aspect, but some angles are more significant than others.

Astrology divides these aspects into "Major" and "Minor" categories. Minor aspects are used primarily in astrological research and for very precisely directed work, so we stick to the Major aspects in our general work. The major aspects are: Conjunction (same degree), Sextile (60 degrees), Square (90 degrees), Trine (120 degrees), and Opposition (180 degrees). Don't worry that some of these individual interpretations may seem to conflict with others. We look at the whole person, and the separate parts can modify, reinforce, or nullify each other.

We have pulled all this data together for you as it is displayed in your birth chart. This whole configuration can not be repeated or duplicated during your lifetime. Although the earth in its rotation around the Sun each year goes through all the twelve sign constellations and returns the Sun to its natal position, it takes Neptune 165 years and Pluto 248 years to complete their orbits. The planets are constantly moving their positions throughout the universe so that it is not possible for all the planetary positions and aspects to repeat themselves in your lifetime.

That leaves it up to us as individuals to deal with those influences imprinted upon us at birth and revealed through the horoscope. It is our hope, through astrology, that we may explain what those influences are and thus understand ourselves better. We have free will to make choices--choices which can affect those birth imprints in positive or negative ways. Probably no one of us will ever fulfill the "promises" of the natal chart in our lifetime, but hopefully, knowing what the influences are could help us to make some better choices.

PLANETARY SIGN AND HOUSE POSITIONS:

The following planetary sign and house positions are determined by YOUR birth data. There are 384 variations of these positions, as well as many other variables, but only 25 of them apply to each individual. The possibility of another person having the same combination of positions is practically non-existent.

The Sun and the Moon are known as the "Lights" and are not planets in the technical sense of the word. However, they are the most visible and perhaps more influential in affecting man's awareness than all of the other heavenly bodies put together. The blend of the Sun-Moon influences, from the signs they are in, and whether they are in aspect or not, are extremely significant to the personality profile of the new life. The relationship of the Sun and Moon to each other by their position, sign, and aspect and their relationship to the Ascendant can sometimes provide us with an extremely accurate mini-interpretation of the chart. The interpretation of your Sun-Moon combination is printed next. Study it carefully--as well as the next three Sun and Moon sign delineations.

SCORPIO SUN AND SAGITTARIUS MOON--Scorpio is in the Fixed mode and an Air sign. Sagittarius is Mutable and Fire. The Moon here gives the higher octave of Scorpio a lift, but it is difficult to apply philosophic ideals to reality. Honor and ethics attract the extreme depths of the Self, but the reasons and applications are not self-evident. Your life purpose could be to combine the Sagittarius idealism with the higher plane of the Scorpio Self, and make it work through service to others. You could be somewhat clairvoyant, you are clever, and your sense of humor could help you keep things in perspective. You could be a good business executive, lawyer, or detective.

SUN IN THE ELEVENTH HOUSE--The Sun in the houses represents the departments of life most strongly affected by the individual will and power potential. In the eleventh house it gives an interest in friendships and group activities. You are also likely to be interested in occult subjects, scientific endeavors, and technological advances. You are likely to have many friends by whom you are held in high esteem. You have a strong sense of the brotherhood of mankind with strong humanitarian feelings. You like to see things in terms of universal laws that apply impartially to all. With your nature toward group leadership, however, you need to beware of any tendency to dominate others for selfish purposes--or tendency to let others dominate you for the same reasons.

MOON IN SAGITTARIUS--In mythology the Moon is always female--as the Sun is always male. In most ancient religions and cults, the Moon represents the female force which reflects the male force of the Sun. In astrology, "she" bestows her indiscriminate influences upon both male and female alike, though each sex might respond to the influences in different ways. The Moon in the signs indicates the emotional responses to life's situations. It determines how you are likely to react to external influences and to the actions of others.

This is not exactly a compatible combination of influences: the sign Sagittarius is masculine, positive, fiery, and mutable, while the Moon is feminine, negative, watery and cardinal. Neither the planet nor the sign have anything in common. At best, this indicates a lofty, idealistic emotional nature. You may aspire to high goals but ignore life's realities. You are likely to be optimistic and cheerful--and ready to cry at a sharp word or a change of expression.

You may appear shy and withdrawn--but still waters run deep. There is nothing shallow about you, and your intellect is sharp and ingenious. You are intuitive to the depth of being psychic in your understanding of what other people may be thinking. But you are probably hesitant to trust and accept the accuracy of these instincts. You were probably schooled in the more traditional religious beliefs which discouraged such "superstitions". However, at some time in your life, you are likely to be compelled, through some unusual circumstances, to adopt a different attitude toward these beliefs.

Intimate relationships could be difficult for you because you may not be a "touchy-feely" kind of person. You will also require freedom and independence in all your relationships, and your partners may not feel you are committed to them. This may not be an accurate presumption, but you may do nothing to refute it. After all, there are so many more interesting people out there! You may choose a partner who is older or younger than you, or of different ethnic or racial background.

You are likely to be somewhat idealistic in your ambition and profession. Your clever mind will adjust to almost any kind of activity, and you can always find a new job if this one doesn't pan out. You could be successful in your own business and you would enjoy the challenge and variety, but you need to keep the goals realistic and down-to-earth.

You may be drawn into a prolonged spiritual search for values you can accept, but then again, you might ignore the whole spiritual thing. Your attitude toward government and politics is likely to be pragmatic, and you may criticize but not vote. You could have difficulty in finding any objectivity in your views of social issues.

MOON IN THE TWELFTH HOUSE--The Moon in the houses indicates the areas of daily activity through which your feelings are manifested, and gives clues to the type of activity on the domestic scene. In the Twelfth House it indicates that your moods and emotional responses are strongly affected by the unconscious and by past experiences. You are extremely emotional, and find it hard to communicate your feelings. This could cause you to be shy and lonely. Your feelings are easily hurt, and you need to guard against any neurotic tendencies and depressions. Your domestic scene could be affected by secret love affairs.

MERCURY IN SAGITTARIUS--Mercury in the signs gives clues to the kinds of concerns that occupy your mind, and reveals your psychological approach to making decisions and conveying your ideas to others. In this sign, it influences your mind to focus on attitudes behind the facts. This kind of approach can give you great insight into social motivation and its subsequent events. You will be much concerned with education, especially in the fields of religion, philosophy, and law. You are direct in speech and will say exactly what you think. Since your ideas are likely to be near the traditional, you will be respected for your directness. You need to keep aware that facts are not always attitudes, and not confuse the two or ignore the facts.

MERCURY IN THE TWELFTH HOUSE--Mercury in the houses deals with the practical affairs that occupy your mind, and shows what areas of activity will be influenced by your thoughts and communications. In the twelfth house, it indicates your thinking is strongly influenced by unconscious memories and past experiences. You may have a tendency to make decisions based on

feelings, since many impressions filter up from the subconscious. You are likely to be secretive about your inner thoughts, and may be shy about saying what you really think. You may gain much knowledge from intuition or psychic ability. Avoid fixating on past experiences not relevant to the present lest it lead to neurotic tendencies.

VENUS IN CAPRICORN--Venus in the signs indicates how you express your emotions in personal relationships, and your attitude toward money, personal possessions, creature comforts, and social and aesthetic values. In Capricorn it bestows a sensual, sexual expression, but the relationships are likely to be serious and mature. In the other areas, it inclines your interest toward business, commerce, banking, investments, stocks, shares, professional sports, and executive positions which bring you contact with many people. You are likely to have a strong sense of composition in art forms with an attraction to classical music and the traditional art which survives the times. You could be very successful in businesses related to the arts, such as professional sports.

VENUS IN THE FIRST HOUSE--Venus in the houses gives us information about how you may express yourself socially, romantically, and artistically in the various areas of your life. In the first house it influences you to be socially outgoing, with a pleasing manner and friendly appearance. It could confer a striking physical beauty as well. You should generally have a happy outlook on life, and your natural ability to mix well with other people should contribute to both good business and exciting romantic opportunities. Artistic talent is also indicated.

MARS IN SCORPIO--Mars, planet of energy gives us information about modes of action as a result of the desire principle. In Scorpio the energy takes on an intensity of depth and determination. You will utilize your power in all areas of your life, especially in "getting ahead", where you will let nothing or nobody get in your way. It would be healthy for you to channel some of this energy through sports activities, and you also need to learn to be sensitive and considerate to the feelings of others.

MARS IN THE ELEVENTH HOUSE--Mars in the houses indicates the departments of life in which you express your actions and desires. It shows where you need to exert energy and initiative in order to produce results. In the eleventh house it indicates energy directed toward friendships and group activities. Your friends are likely to be of masculine, aggressive types, whether male or female, and they can help you with your ambitions. You are mentally alert and probably have good mechanical understanding and ability. You will want to spend much of your energy on social reform. You need to curb your impulsiveness.

JUPITER IN VIRGO--Jupiter in the signs indicates your ethical, religious, and philosophical standards and beliefs, and how you may express these interests. In the sign Virgo, it instills a cautious, analytical view of things. You will focus on the materialistic with prudence and discrimination. You will have a passion for details, and will need to practice looking at the broader picture. Honesty and integrity are the foundations of your nature and you will demand cleanliness and order in your activities. Your religious and philosophical interests will find their strongest expression in service to others, but high ideals will not fly unless they have a practical application. Avoid making moral decisions for others and trying to be all things to all people. Don't promise more than you can deliver.

JUPITER IN THE NINTH HOUSE--Jupiter in the houses indicates the departments of life and types of activity through which you express your religious, philosophical, and educational ideas. In this house it gives you a deep love for all three subjects. You have a keen interest in all clarification of thought regarding these subjects, and will seek to acquire as much education as possible. As a result, you will be good at teaching, lecturing, and publishing. You are interested in other cultures, and are broad-minded and tolerant of other peoples and their customs. This could initiate the desire to travel. The negative side of this house position cautions you against laziness, indifference to discipline, and extremist religious beliefs.

SATURN IN CANCER--Saturn in the signs indicates the areas in which you must accept responsibility and the ways in which you must practice discipline and develop maturity. In Cancer, it can cause moodiness and dissatisfied feelings. You may have difficulty in expressing emotion, and, when you are hurting you are likely to withdraw into a shell. You need approval and emotional support, but may cover up those needs by presenting a cold, austere demeanor. You need to practice discipline with your emotions, and develop trust in others. Call upon positive psychic sources to help you develop your highest qualities.

SATURN IN THE SEVENTH HOUSE--Saturn in the houses indicates the areas of life in which we must learn to act with discipline and to express practical ambition through maturity. In seven, it gives you a strong sense of responsibility and justice in relationships and public affairs. You will work hard and conscientiously with others. You are reliable in work, honor contracts, may be interested in law, and will have business organizational ability. Avoid allowing yourself to become inhibited, negative, and critical. Seek positive spiritual guidance and avoid alcohol and other drugs.

URANUS IN GEMINI--Uranus in the signs indicates the ways in which you express your urge for freedom and individuality, and how you establish your link with the Universal Mind. In Gemini, it bestows brilliant, original, intuitive minds. You may find it difficult to follow an idea through to completion because of extreme mental restlessness. You need mental freedom for new ways of thinking. You also need to exert self-discipline and concentration. You are likely to break with habitual living patterns, maybe often, but you need to practice acceptance of other's ways of living.

URANUS IN THE SIXTH HOUSE--The house position of Uranus indicates the type of activity through which you express your urge toward individuality and freedom. In the sixth house it indicates some strange and advanced methods used in work and service, especially in the areas of healing and diet. Electronics specialists, computer programmers, and others whose work involves advanced technology often have this house position for Uranus. It can bestow inventiveness and originality applied to practical problems. You are sensitive to working conditions and co-workers, and may find it difficult to accept routine.

NEPTUNE IN LIBRA--Neptune in the signs manifests more historical and generational influences than personal. It indicates the kind of cultural expression shown by the imaginative and creative faculties. In your personal responses, this position bestows you with an intuitive awareness of social relationships, and the concept of mutual social responsibilities. You may have a desire to challenge the establishment, such as the institution of marriage. You are likely to have an interest in new art forms. On the negative side, the stage is set for a desire for escapism through the abuse of alcohol

and drugs.

NEPTUNE IN THE NINTH HOUSE--Neptune in the houses indicates how you express your mystical potential, and may reveal some of the karma produced by your past actions. Since the ninth house focuses on religion, the influences of Neptune are very strong here. Positive spirituality can be powerful and prophetic vision is possible. The interest will surely be in the mystical forms of religion, and much seeking through study, prayer, and meditation may be necessary for you to find what is right for you. Beware of cultism and negative influences. Take care to distinguish the real spiritual teachers from the false, and do not fall victim to your own spiritual pride. You are especially vulnerable to the influences of alcohol and other drugs.

PLUTO IN LEO--Pluto in the signs is also historical and generational, but on a personal level it indicates permanent change. In Leo it will make those changes in the areas of leadership, indicating that you could be a leader in your field, and, though the struggle may be great, the achievement could be sudden. But when it comes, it is likely to be permanent.

PLUTO IN THE EIGHTH HOUSE--Pluto in the houses indicates in which departments of life you need to exercise conscious creative willpower to regenerate yourself and your surroundings. Eighth house focus is on the continuity of the consciousness after loss of the physical body, or, life after death. Search for faith may include studies in astrology, yoga, meditation, karma, reincarnation, and other occult subjects. You must concentrate on the positive in order to find the true way for you. Your higher spiritual powers are likely to be positive, and you will be able to overcome the negative, in yourself as well as others. Avoid temptation to use your powers for purely personal gain.

PLANETARY ASPECTS:

Following are the interpretations of the planetary aspects to each other. Aspects are angular relationships between two or more planets that have been found to modify the influences bestowed. Significant angles are: Conjunction (same degree), Sextile (60 degrees), Square (90 degrees), Trine (120 degrees), and Opposition (180 degrees). Don't worry that some of these individual interpretations seem to conflict. Remember--we look at the whole person, and the separate parts can modify, reinforce, or nullify each other.

SUN CONJUNCT MARS--This conjunction demands action. Your willpower directs you into activities which require strength and courage, and you are likely to be aggressive and self-assertive. The power from the Sun and the action from Mars will not let you be still for very long at a time. You will need to practice tolerance and patience, especially in how you use your aggressiveness. When positively applied, this combination can be an awesome force in achieving whatever you set out to do.

SUN TRINE THE NORTH NODE--This aspect confers leadership ability and indicates public favor and popularity. It offers the ability to exercise your will and express yourself in harmony with the prevailing social attitudes and institutions.

SUN SEXTILE JUPITER--This aspect bestows an optimistic and generous nature. You are charitable to those in need, and are likely to be philosophical about it. You have good mental abilities as well as spiritual sensitivity. You seem to be "protected from all harm" and lead a charmed life. You are likely to accomplish your goals because of your optimism and self-confidence, and your insight into constructive ways to overcome difficulties. You will like to travel and understand other cultures.

MOON CONJUNCT MERCURY--This aspect provides direct linkage between the subconscious mind and the conscious thinking mind. You have direct access to information stored in the subconscious, especially if it were stored with emotional emphasis. You are sensitive to what others think of you, and may be super-sensitive to personal remarks and criticisms. Much of your thinking will be of domestic and family affairs, especially in the areas of food and health.

MOON OPPOSITE URANUS--Oppositions, like squares, provide obstacles in our paths. This is an emotional aspect which can cause sudden changes in moods and attitudes. It can create nervous tension which is expressed by irritability. You may appear unpredictable and undependable to others. You may crave unusual experiences and even court danger to find them. Sudden emotional decisions are likely, and new friends may be made suddenly and impulsively. The challenge here is to meld these two influences into cooperation with each other. Cultivate patience and try to curb your impulsiveness. Seek positive psychic influences which will be supportive to spiritual growth and serenity.

MOON TRINE PLUTO--This trine provides for positive emotional regeneration of yourself and (possibly) your environment. It can give you strong emotional intensity, and still allow your feelings to remain under the control of your will. This is a rare blend of will and emotions, and can provide

tremendous power to overcome obstacles to material and spiritual success. You can transform thought into material, objective manifestation, for you know instinctively that "thoughts are things".

MOON SEXTILE THE MIDHEAVEN--This pattern is favorable for harmonious home life and family relationships. You can adjust to and accept routine responsibility, and are able to cooperate in professional matters with employers and employees.

MERCURY OPPOSITE URANUS--Oppositions usually mean obstacles to be overcome and this is no exception. You could be blunt and tactless, arrogant and conceited. No one else could make you change your mind about anything, but you may change it without the slightest justification. The key here is to "lighten up". Don't be afraid to be wrong. Cultivate patience and cooperation with others whether you agree with them or not (and you probably won't). Try to avoid snap judgments and sudden decisions--"look before you leap". Seek spiritual guidance for the use of the awesome power this aspect can provide.

MERCURY TRINE PLUTO--This trine gives you the ability to get to the bottom of things. You have good powers of concentration and can use your willpower intelligently, giving you the ability to increase your mental abilities and improve your mind in the areas of communication. You probably like mystery stories, and could write them as well. You have a sensitivity to nuclear science, but this can also be interpreted as an interest in the occult.

MERCURY SEXTILE NEPTUNE--This sextile adds the support of the mystical to the intelligence of Mercury. Your perceptions are likely to be keen and delicate and may sometimes come through by way of clairvoyance. This aspect is favorable for creative writers and photographers. Financial or military strategists can utilize the ability to anticipate their opponent's moves. You have ability to work in secret and bypass intervention and opposition.

VENUS CONJUNCT THE ASCENDANT--This conjunction bestows upon you a pleasant appearance and personal mannerisms which are pleasing and harmonious. Your ability to express these qualities bring harmony and beauty into your surroundings. You need to appreciate the source of these gifts, use them appropriately, and avoid any tendencies toward narcissism.

VENUS SQUARE NEPTUNE--This square can cause emotional and sexual problems from past experiences hidden in the subconscious mind. It could be a karmic influence. Sexual imagery can inflame the passions causing unhealthy relationships and affairs. You can waste your affections on unworthy recipients, with the likelihood of justifying sexual desires by giving them the name of love. You could be very sensitive to sexual responses and easily hurt by any implication of failure to please. You could become an easy prey to those who feign sympathy and understanding. The lesson to be learned is restraint. Reinforce self-worth in every positive way, and seek trustworthy friends for support. Avoid alcohol and drugs.

MARS TRINE NODE--This configuration bestows social harmony with accepted modes of behavior. You are likely to be popular and to have the energy to deal with social trends and institutions. You are able to time your actions so that they will be in harmony with the trends of the times.

MARS SEXTILE JUPITER--This aspect provides enthusiasm and energy in work, self-expression, and self-improvement. You will be optimistic and will not acknowledge defeat. Your religious inclinations are likely to be very practical, and you will work hard for the underprivileged. You are not lazy, and are likely to achieve a good degree of success in the material comforts.

JUPITER SQUARE THE ASCENDANT--This aspect can cause you to appear cold and unresponsive to others. Your ability to relate with friendliness and warmth seems to be blocked. Indicates possible marital and relationship problems.

JUPITER SEXTILE NODE--This aspect may encourage religious activities in the traditional sense, and can be good for social events.

SATURN SQUARE NEPTUNE--This square is likely to conjure up fears, anxieties, neuroses, and phobias that infiltrate from the subconscious. These are most often demonstrated by fears of inadequacy and an inferiority complex. You can feel confused about career and practical responsibilities, and may want to escape responsibility. It may appear that you have to work harder than others to accomplish anything. You could have a sense of morbidity, thinking that things always go wrong for you. Remember, squares in the natal chart present difficulties to be overcome by personal growth, and this is one of the more difficult ones. You can be especially susceptible to negative psychic influences, and need to be very careful to seek out only the positive forces from the occult. Cultivate a link with your Primal Creative Force through positive prayer and meditation. No one can tell you exactly how to do that, but sincere effort will help you find the way. Resist tendencies to be cunning and devious by practicing openness and honesty. Remember, Saturn is the planet of discipline and Neptune rules hidden meanings and spiritual yearnings. Try constantly and faithfully to keep this conflict out in the open.

URANUS TRINE NEPTUNE--This trine indicates a very high development of spiritual faculties. It is an aspect of long duration and affects a whole generation of people, but pin-points in your own horoscope a decided leaning toward the mystical and the occult. It is not surprising that you have an interest in astrology, ESP, and reincarnation, and, that you seek the company of individuals and groups who are in tune with the occult. Beware of Utopian tendencies, however, and seek only the positive in psychic powers.

URANUS SEXTILE PLUTO--This aspect can indicate a natural attunement with the forces of nature. You could be extremely psychic, and will need to develop these powers in positive ways. You are likely to make new discoveries in Nature or metaphysics. You could become involved in some movement toward regeneration of the earth as a result of personal discoveries.

NEPTUNE SEXTILE PLUTO--This aspect has more general and historical connotations than personal, but in the personal interpretation it indicates unusual occult, intuitive, scientific, and aesthetic abilities. It could generate sudden and secret changes. You need to concentrate on the positive occult powers.

INTERPRETATION, PERSONALITY PROFILE

Getting together all the information that makes up the face of your chart has primarily been mathematical and scientific--in a word, technical. The computer has used the date, time, and place of your birth to select and print out the interpretations of your Sun-sign, your Rising Sign (Ascendant), the Signs on the Houses, the Signs and Houses the Planets are in, and the aspects of the Planets to each other. These interpretations apply only to YOU.

In interpreting the total Personality Profile, however, we must add two more dimensions to the technical: "Symbolism" and "Intuition". These operate mainly from our subconscious mind. Allow your intuition full play as you carefully study the face of the chart and allow its symbolism to "speak" to you. Often the chart can provide a key which opens the subconscious. If you don't consciously "feel" anything, don't worry about it. Just allow the full power of your intuition to apply, and keep your mind as open as you possibly can.

Now go back and read the printouts again: all the way from the Sun-sign through the aspects of Pluto. Try not to reject any statement--not those you dislike, or even those you like. Note any statement which you strongly agree or disagree with, and mark it for later study. Then add all statements which seem to contradict each other to the list. When you study the "contradictive" statements, try to determine if any of them might apply to you at a different time, or in a different place. Then consider if the pair could modify each other and produce an interpretation that does apply to you.

Astrology is not judgmental--it just IS. It doesn't tell us what is "good" or "bad", it only tells us what the influences are. We give the most optimistic and positive interpretation to that information that we possibly can. However, it has been our experience that often the most valuable information we can get from a chart is the awareness of those obstacles and stresses we need to overcome in order to grow and fulfill our lives according to our own individual value systems.
